Volunteer requirements

As a volunteer, you must:

- Be at least 16 years old
- Pass a criminal background check (if 18 or older)
- Agree to a 6-month commitment of at least 4 hours per week
- Be available Monday through Friday from 8 am to 4 pm
 - Evening and weekend opportunities are available at Huntley Hospital and Woodstock Hospital.
- Participate in a new-volunteer orientation
- Complete an immunization screening and undergo a TB test
- Fulfill the current COVID-19 vaccine requirement and provide supporting documentation
- Receive a flu vaccine (if volunteering during flu season, December 1 through May 1)
